



## Implementing the European Standard in consolidated eInvoicing cloud platforms

### Project objective

The main objective of the EURINV Project is pushing and supporting seven EDI providers and two public institutions to become conformant with the EN European standard on electronic invoicing, based on the UBL 2.1 and CII formats, allowing cross-border transactions according to the 2014/55/EU Directive and the regulations of the Member States.

The project includes two fundamental technical activities:

- Adapting each eInvoicing cloud solution to the said EN standard, so as to be enabled for exchanging documents in the devised formats.
- Undergoing strict conformance and interoperability tests to assure that the adapted solutions can effectively support cross-border transactions.

### SATA focus

The reason for SATA to take part in the EURINV project is strengthening its HUB MultiDOC eInvoicing solution to cope with the EN standard and then testing it in the Slovakian case, thus becoming a validated solution at the European scale.

To that purpose SATA foresees the following developments:

- Completing the HUB internal eInvoice data meta-model to capture the EN standard semantics, and mapping it on the Italian and Slovakian CIUSs.
- Studying, together with the Economic University of Bratislava, the vocabulary of terms used in Slovakian invoices to manage them with regular expressions.
- Adapting the HUB Italian and English GUIs, and developing a brand-new Slovakian GUI, based on the extended EN standard data meta-model.
- Developing some std2custom and custom2std connectors to interface the HUB with selected ERP systems issuing and receiving invoices.
