Adopting the European Standard by using consolidated eInvoicing cloud platforms

Project objective

The objective of the EURINV19 Project is twofold: (i) update the eInvoicing cloud platforms of five EDI providers to become fully compliant with the EN European standard on electronic invoicing, based on the UBL 2.1 and CII formats, and (ii) implement eInvoicing solutions compliant with the EN standard at four end users (public and private entities).

The project includes two fundamental technical activities:

- Adapting each eInvoicing cloud solution to the said EN standard, taking into account the end user existing systems, procedures and integration requirements.
- Undergoing strict conformance and cross-border interoperability tests to assure that the adapted solutions can effectively support cross-border transactions.

SATA focus

The reason for SATA to take part in the EURINV19 project is supporting TATRA BILLING (Slovakia) to build its own eInvoicing service based upon the HUB MultiDOC platform, thus empowering its capability to support cross-border processes.

To that purpose SATA foresees the following developments:

- Enabling the HUB MultiDOC platform for TATRA BILLING taking into account their national context and conditions.
- Analyzing the TATRA BILLING ERP system and its proprietary eInvoice format and vocabulary.
- Developing the std2custom and custom2std connectors to interface HUB MultiDOC with the TATRA BILLING ERP system.
- Demonstrating correct eInvoice reception from a sample of TATRA BILLING suppliers and eInvoice issuing towards a sample of TATRA BILLING customers through the new eInvoicing solution.
