## Cross-border authentication in European cloud platforms according to the eIDAS Regulation

### Project objective

The main objective of the EUROLogin action is to foster the adoption of the eIDAS Regulation by using the recently-implemented national eIDAS nodes as main authentication channels to cloud services, with special attention to the services offered by private providers.

The project is organized into three main technical activities:

- Solution design, means definition in each country of the authentication architecture able to support cross-border access to the intended cloud service.
- Connection to the eIDAS node, means implementation of the link between the provided cloud service and its national eIDAS node.
- Conformance tests, means demonstration that the service has become accessible to users from other EU Countries through the eIDAS network.

### SATA focus

SATA aims at making accessible through the eIDAS network its CE (Cloud Extraction) service, automatically extracting contents from PDF invoices and generating the homologous electronic documents. The following picture represents the devised authentication architecture relying on the eIDAS network functionality depicted in green.
